## WHAT ADMISSIONS IS OKING FOR


- Passion for dentistry

- Reflections on challenges and growth.




# HOW TO START

- Begin early by jotting down ideas (google doc, notes app).
- Outline --> what have you done to get you to this point, what has shaped you, experiences that have reaffirmed your passion.
- Connection btwn all ideas!!








Experiences that have shaped your perspectives:

- Shadowing
- Community service/ giving back
- Personal dental experiences
- Leadership experiences
- Patient Doctor relationship
- Oral Systemic link
- Mentorship / Guidance



- Intro: Engaging anecdote.
- **Body Paragraphs**: Experiences, reflections, and connections to dentistry.
- **Conclusion**: Reinforce passion, commitment, and future goals.







- Lots of drafts lol :)

- Don't blindly accept suggestions!!!




• Show don't tell. Demonstrate your character through examples.

 $\times$  **Tell**: My aunt inspired me to pursue dentistry. **Show**: I watched as my aunt greeted each patient not just with a handshake, but with a warm embrace. A farmer handed her a basket of fresh mangoes as payment, and she laughed, tucking them into her bag before preparing his treatment.





- How you will contribute to your class and future in the field.
- "Don't mention specializing"
- Don't fixate on character count
- Don't share your personal statement during the cycle



### THINGS TO AVOID

- Putting it off.
- Cliches.
- Obtaining too many opinions.
- Big/ fancy words.
- Negative experiences.
- Speaking poorly about other professions.
- Don't restate your resume.
- No conjugations or abbreviations.
- Listing achievements or qualities.
